Preconsultation Info



- * Look over all the info provided with a parent and decide which portrait sessions you wish to have created.
- * Call us to schedule your appointment to be photographed: 337-365-0570. Appointments are limited so HURRY with your decisions! Have your Visa, Master Card or Discover card ready to pay your session fees to hold your appointment time.
- * The day of your session come ready to be a STAR! Bring each outfit together on a hanger to be sure not to forget anything. Remember shoes, class ring, belts, and accessories for each outfit. Be careful of your clothes if its baggy you tend to look larger than you are. Make sure your clothes flatter you... but not too tight either. Remember your clothing can create your MOOD!
- * Bring as many props as you can. Props help to define who you are--sports equipment, uniforms, senior jacket, hobbies, vehicles, friends or pets.
- * Avoid changing your hairstyle or cutting your hair right brfore you session. Let it be natural. Bring brush, straightener, curling iron, gel, and any other hair products you may need just in case.
- ***** Guys be sure to shave the morning of your session.
- * Make sure your polish goes with each outfit. Avoid bright colors. Many casual poses are taken barefoot, so don't forget about your toes.
- * Most glasses glare. If possible, visit your eye doctor and borrow a pair of empty frames.
- * Avoid Sunburn! Be careful tan lines are hard to hide.
- * Make-up should be slightly heavier than normal. Be carefull of clumps in your mascara.
- * In the event that its raining the day of your session, please come in and take all of your indoor photographs. It is much easier to reschedule one or two sessions than all of them.

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
